Greetings from St. Peter's School to Our Dear Alumni & Friends,

Good News! 100% of students have returned safely for in-person learning here on campus. We continue to follow all COVID-19 safety protocols and feel blessed to be fully back in community!



With all students back in classrooms, teachers can resume using the small group instruction and individualized literacy and mathematics curricula that prompted twice as many students to score higher on STAR tests between 2018-2019 and 2019-2020. Literacy

coaches are joining teachers in the classroom to offer helpful educational techniques across the subjects. In addition, we anticipate implementing a new English Language Arts program that meets the needs of our many English Language Learners.

St. Peter's is grateful for our many partners who support our mission in delivering a quality Catholic education to our students:

- The BASIC Fund which provides much-needed tuition assistance for over half of our student body every year;
- Our full-time Mercy Corps volunteer, who helps both in the classroom and with school church ceremonies;
- University of San Francisco graduate students who assist in classrooms and undergraduate students who tutor students virtually;
- Our Title I funded Reading and Math tutor from Catapult and School Counselors-in-Training from the Center for Child and Family Development;
- and Catholic Youth Organization team sports, starting with boys' soccer and girls' volleyball seasons, with the volunteer services of St. Peter's coaches.

Such partnerships allow us to build a school community that nurtures the whole child--academically, socially, emotionally, spiritually, and physically.

Our most recent St. Peter's graduates--the Class of 2021--showed us that their school community has left a

lasting, positive impact on their growth and development. The mural they designed and painted illustrates their love for their Catholic faith, the Sisters of Mercy, the St. Peter's Aztec spirit, and their "open hearts and open minds." We are proud of their accomplishments here at St. Peter's School, especially as they endured their 8th-grade year of hybrid learning, and we can't wait to see where their high school journey will take them!



Because of community support like yours, St. Peter's can maintain affordable tuition for our families and provide such experiences--like creating an original mural--here at St. Peter's.

This year, fundraising will continue for our fire safety system upgrade. We also seek additional gifts for our 7th graders to attend CYO/Caritas Environmental Camp--an experience that former students have identified as one of their favorite memories with their classmates.

The pandemic presented St. Peter's with many challenges, and we greatly appreciate all the supportive phone calls, prayers, and donations we received. 


